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Dear Retirees and Member Units:

As you have been aware, since Governor Baker declared a State of Emergency in March 2020, the limit of hours and earnings a superannuation retiree were able to work/earn in the public sector was waived. Please be aware that the State of Emergency ends June 15, 2021.

With the end of the State of Emergency, so too does the waiver on the limitations on hours and earnings a superannuation retiree can work and earn in the public sector. Effective June 15, 2021, public retirees working in the public sector will need to track their hours worked to ensure they do not exceed 960 for the year. Earnings per year cannot exceed the difference between the retirement allowance the retiree is receiving and the current rate for the position from which the employee was retired or terminated from. If a retiree has been retired for a full year, the retiree may earn an additional \$15,000. As always, there are no restrictions on a public retiree who does work in the private sector.

Adherence to the post-retirement restrictions in any year is the responsibility of both the retiree and the employer that has hired them.
